## Building Use and Condition

Cascade is located at the corner of 23rd Street and North Baker Avenue in East Wenatchee, Washington. Cascade is the newest of the Eastmont School District's five elementary schools, built in 1968. The building was remodeled in 1993, when a new "pod" and gym were added. During the school year a Student Care program is provided on site at a reasonable cost for Cascade students. Our facilities are used extensively as a meeting place.

## School Improvement Plan

The Cascade staff works collaboratively to develop, implement, evaluate, and revisit the School Improvement Plan. The Student Improvement teams developed areas of focus for professional development, curriculum, instruction and parent involvement, with goals and activities for each one.

Our goals for 2005-06 are:

**Reading:** To improve student success in reading 25% the number of students meeting the standard on the Grade 4 WASL reading assessment. At the end of the 2006 academic school year, the percentage of 4th grade students who are reaching a standard of performance on the Reading portion of the WASL assessment will increase from 81% to 86%.

**Math:** To improve student success in math by 25% the number of students meeting the standard on the Grade 4 WASL math assessment. By the end of the 2006 academic school year, the percentage of 4th grade students who are reaching a standard of performance on the Math portion of the WASL assessment will increase from 61% - 66%.

I-728 funds were used to provide extended day learning classes and summer school. In addition, our staff development funds were used to provide training for teachers in Writing, Reading, Math, and Intel technology training.
