

Booster Club Minutes 9/12/2006

- I. Pride Letters – Mr. Countryman gave a presentation on a business he has started to promote spirit and pride in our students. He showed examples of the yard ornaments, Pride Letters, and showed an order sheet. The letters cost \$40, and he will give \$5 back to booster club for every letter sold. We would display the letters and collect orders, he will do everything else including deliver orders.

Will also find out if we can add a booster club sheet to the "Sports Clearance Packet."
- VI. Will sell clothes at HS Open House – Adele will help.
- VII. All Sports Pass will be available to purchase at the High School main office. See Mrs. Bromiley.
- VIII. Program Update- sales are going well, all nights have sellers assigned. Will move the organization from the concession stand to the clothing table.
- IX. Clothing sales are going well, we need lights when we set up inside the gates.
- X. Concession Stand – nobody is allowed in the concession stand unless they are working. Programs and 50/50 will be moved to the clothing table. Need one more person for nachos.
- XI. Add Board Positions: Lisa made a motion to add 2 Board positions, effective immediately. Concession Manager and Volunteer Coordinator. The motion was seconded. Nominations were taken for both positions.
- XII. Website – it is up to date and looking good.
- XIII. Flagpoles – Jan Cetto is working with Pam Lily.
- XIV. New Ideas: Rent a storage shed to be placed by the football field for Fall storage. Begin next year.
